



Beginning Monday, March 30th, 2020 Republic Services will have a **temporary** change in the bulky waste pick-up services. The bulky waste services has been cancelled until further notice. Republic Services focus is on continued daily operation. Since families are sheltering at home and volume has increased dramatically, some adjustments to normal operations are required in order to ensure collection services. There will be no change to the trash service which is picked up once-a-week.

- No bulky waste service for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month. The Spring Cleanup has also been cancelled. Please do not place bulky items at the curb. They will not be picked up.
- Trash service will remain the same, there is no change. Carts should be curbside by 7 a.m., with 3 feet of space between any other objects such as cars, mailboxes, fences, etc.
- Green waste collection will continue, however we anticipate delays in service. By taking the following steps, residents can help minimize these delays:
  - Mulch leaves and grass clippings instead of bagging them for disposal.
  - Limit the amount of pruning and aesthetic tree trimming to only what's essential.
  - If utilizing a landscape company, ensure that all green waste is collected and hauled off by the contractor.
